## Karin M. Muraszko Honor Your Mentor Fund

Applications for the **Karin M. Muraszko Mentorship Award** are being accepted by the **AANS/CNS Section on Women in Neurosurgery (WINS)** through the **Neurosurgery Research & Education Foundation (NREF)**.

**Fund Purpose** To help develop leaders in neurosurgery by providing mentoring and didactic education.

**Award Description** Awardee will have the opportunity for networking and mentorship with leaders and members of WINS during exclusive events held at the AANS Annual Scientific Meeting on Saturday, May 4, 2024:

**Amount of Award** \$1,000 honorarium, plus reimbursement of travel expenses (up to \$2,000)

**Eligibility** Applicants must be female medical students in good standing enrolled in an accredited program in the United States, Canada or Mexico and have completed at least one (1) year of medical school by the start of the 2024 AANS Annual Scientific Meeting in Chicago, IL. (May 3-6, 2024).

**Reporting** A summary (minimum: 500 words) report is required within forty (40) days of completion.
