## Shelly D. Timmons Honor Your Mentor Fund

Applications for the **Shelly D. Timmons Leadership Award** are being accepted by the **AANS/CNS Section on Women in Neurosurgery** through the **Neurosurgery Research & Education Foundation (NREF)**.

**Fund Purpose** To support leadership development for all young neurosurgeons

<b>Award Description</b>	One-time fellowship in developing leadership skills. The Awardee will have mentoring and shadowing opportunities with past and current WINS leaders at an AANS or other meeting. Additional mentors may be included on mutual agreement to tailor the experience to the Awardee's goals.
<b>Amount of Award</b>	Reimbursement of travel expenses (up to a maximum of \$1,000)
<b>Application Deadline</b>	Submit application to <a href="mailto:info@nref.org">info@nref.org</a> by <b>Friday, December 19, 2025</b> . Award notification is planned for February 2026.
<b>Eligibility</b>	Applicants must be either (1) physicians who have been accepted into, or who are currently in approved residency training programs in neurological surgery; or (2) neurosurgeons, no more than two years from having completed their neurosurgical residency training, and/or clinical fellowship, who are full-time faculty in a teaching institution or employed in private practice in the United States, Canada or Mexico.  Membership in the <b>AANS/CNS Section on Women in Neurosurgery</b> is encouraged, but not mandatory
<b>Reporting</b>	A final summary (minimum: 500 words) and expense report (for reimbursement) is required within forty (40) days of fellowship completion.

- **Letter of Reference** – Please submit a letter from a board-certified neurosurgeon who is a member of the American Association of Neurological Surgeons (AANS).
- **Photo** – Please submit a professional, high-resolution photo in JPG format.
